FBA initiated/reviewed or revised student's Functional Behavior Assessment.

BIP. Developed/reviewed or revised student's Behavior Intervention Plan.

Meeting held. Meeting held with parents and/or others to provide support to student.

Options/choices. Offered student options and/or choices.

Quiet space. Offered student a quiet space/location.

Sensory tools/calming. Offered student sensory tools and/or calming techniques.

Walk. Offered the student a walk/went for a walk with student.

Positive reinforcement system. Utilized student's individualized positive reinforcement system.

Breaks. Provide/offer student to take a break.

Remove triggers. Remove known triggers from the environment.

Staff switch. Switch staffing to a different staff member.
