

WHERE TO GO FOR IMMUNIZATIONS AND RECORDS

If you do not have a record of your child's immunizations:

1. Contact your health care provider's office to see if they have the records.
2. If your health care provider's office does **not** have the records, call other schools or daycare facilities that your child attended.
3. If you still cannot find your child's immunization record, call Multnomah County Health Department, Community Immunization Program, at (503) 988-4724.

If you have the Oregon Health Plan, no insurance, or if your insurance does not cover the full cost of immunizations for your child, you may attend one of the following community or School Health Center clinics.

No Cost Immunization at Student Health Centers

All Multnomah County school-age youth (5-18) can get health care, including immunizations, at any of the four Multnomah County Student Health Centers (SHCs). SHCs accept all types of insurance and uninsured clients. **There is no out-of-pocket cost for any services at SHCs - no cost for immunizations or co-pays.** Your child does not need to attend the school where the clinic is located. They can visit any Student Health Center location. Call the clinic for an appointment.
