Electrical Shock

Note

If you see the telephone symbol () next to any sign below occurring in the student, call for help (EMS/9-1-1, school nurse, first aid-trained staff).

Look for

- Unresponsive
- Cannot get the student to respond; student not able to follow directions or think clearly
- Absence of breathing
- Hard, rapid or slow, shallow breathing
- Pale, bluish, cold, clammy skin
- Burns or other injury

Listen for statements about

Tingling sensation

Action

- 1. Approach student ONLY when power source is shut off.
- 2. Begin CPR (p. 37) for absent breathing if you are trained.
- 3. Follow burn (p. 27) and wound guidelines (p. 75) if these signs are present in the student.
- 4. Apply clean, preferably sterile, dry dressing.
- 5. Refer all incidents for prompt medical attention.
