Hypothermia

Note

If you see the telephone symbol () next to any sign below occurring in the student, call for help (EMS/9-1-1, school nurse, first aid-trained staff).

Look for

- Unresponsive
- Cannot get the student to respond; student not able to follow directions or think clearly
- Cold, pale, bluish skin
- Shivering to loss of shivering
- Rapid to slowing heart rate

Action

1. **DO NOT**:

- Allow student to walk if feet are frozen.
- Apply direct heat, i.e. hot water, a heating pad, or lamp.

DO:

- 2. Move student out of the cold; if not possible, shield from the weather as much as possible and insulate the student's body from the cold ground with blankets, coats, etc.
- 3. Gently remove student's wet clothing and wrap the student (including the head) in warm, dry blankets.
- 4. If student is alert and swallowing well, provide warm non-caffeinated and non-alcoholic beverages.
