

Program Description

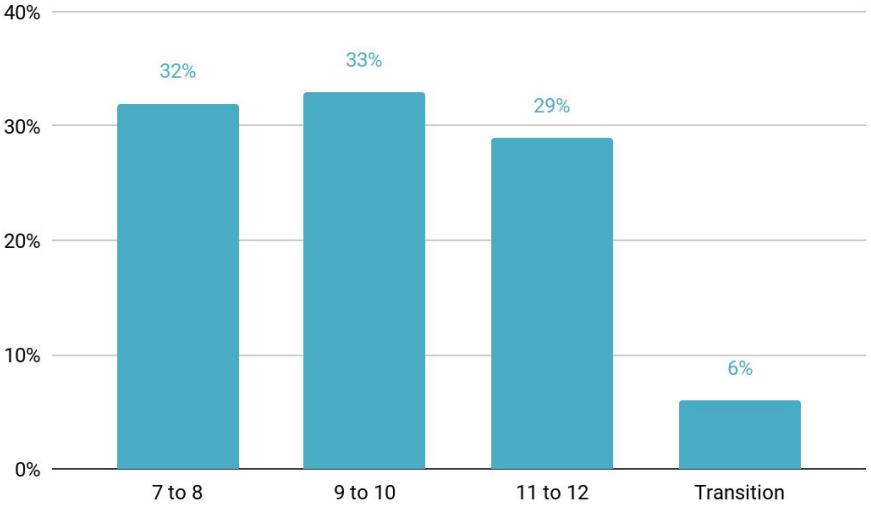

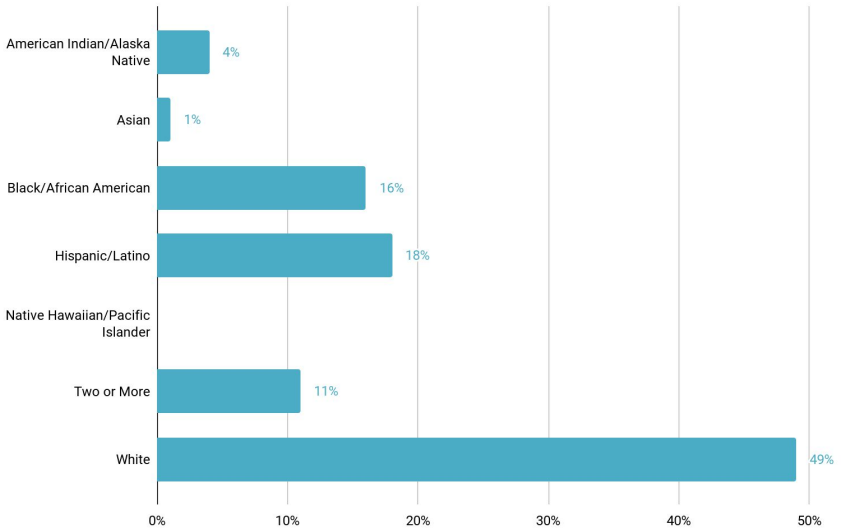

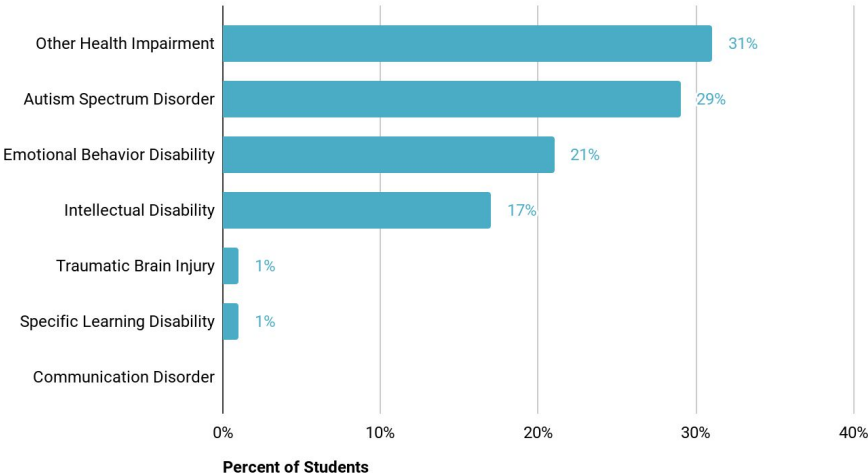
Grade Levels Served



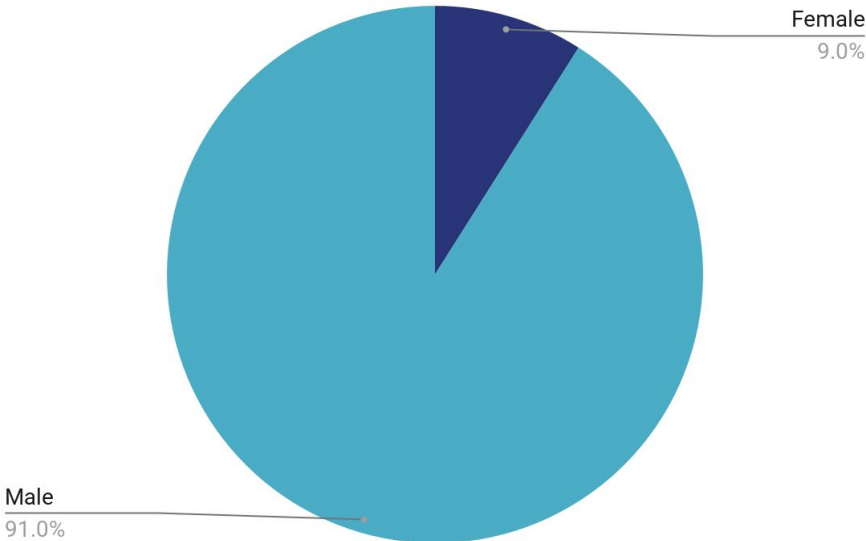
Race/Ethnicity of Students Served

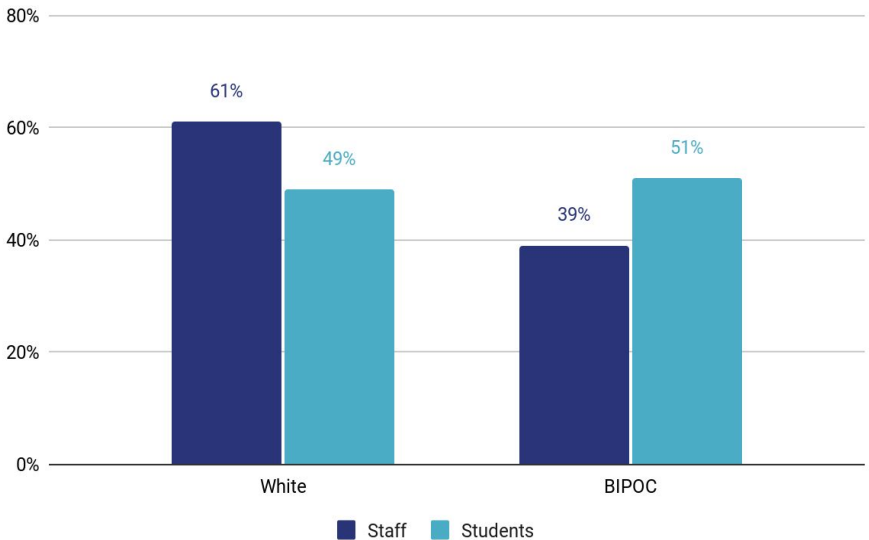

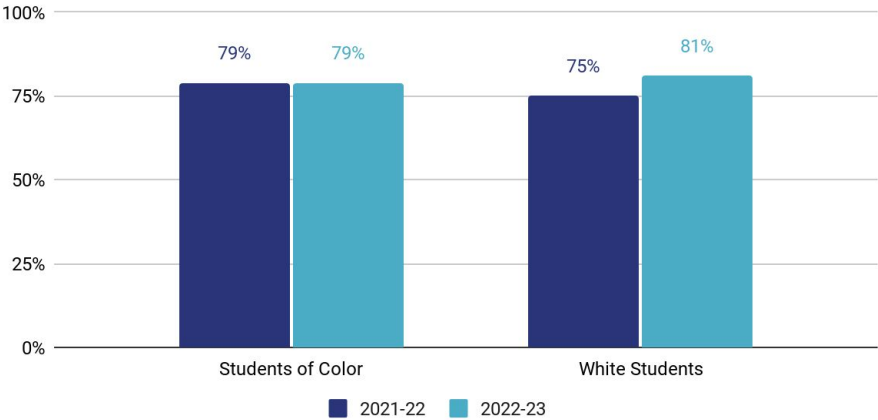

Disaggregated Student Average Daily Attendance
