Program Description

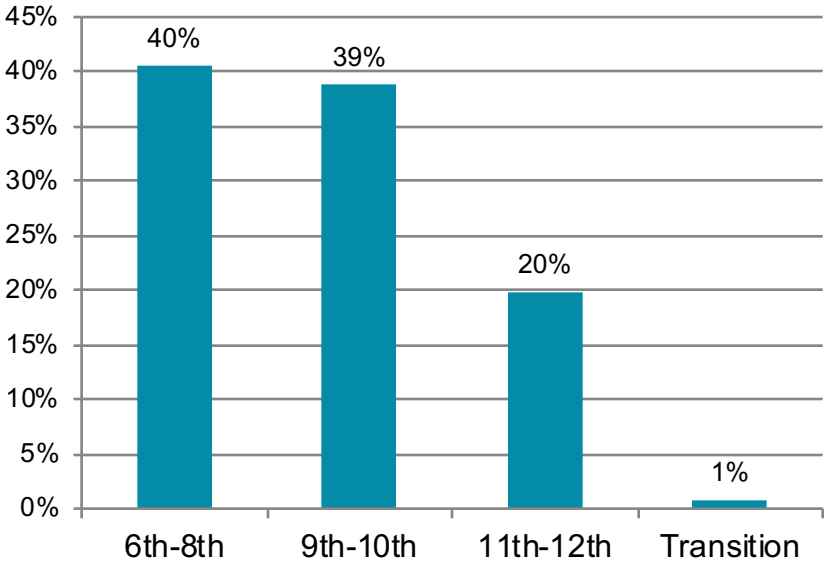

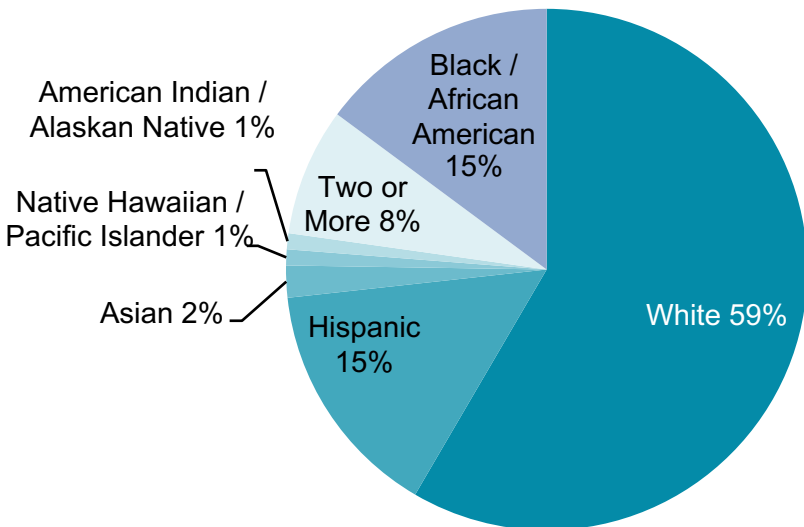

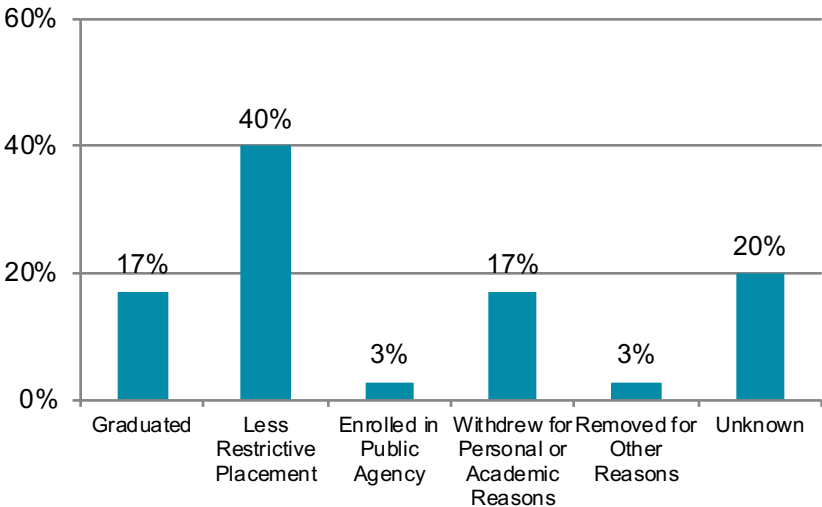

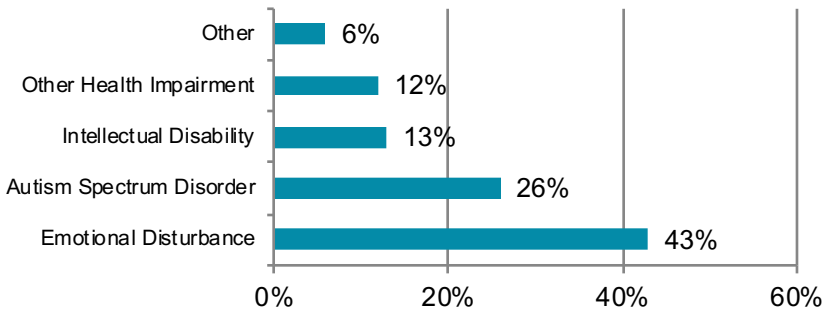

STAR assessments are taken as pre and post at 12-week intervals. Growth is indicated as the averaging of all 12-week intervals in a school year. Student growth is measured as Grade Equivalent.
