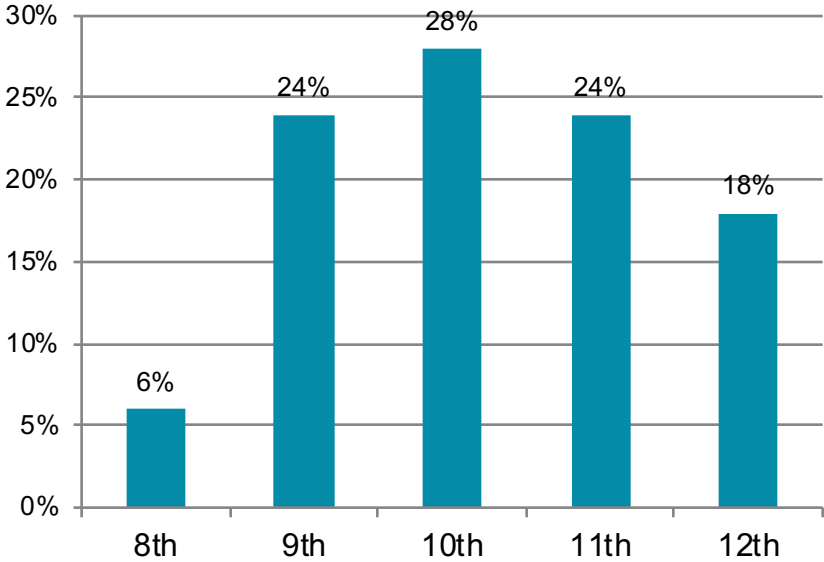

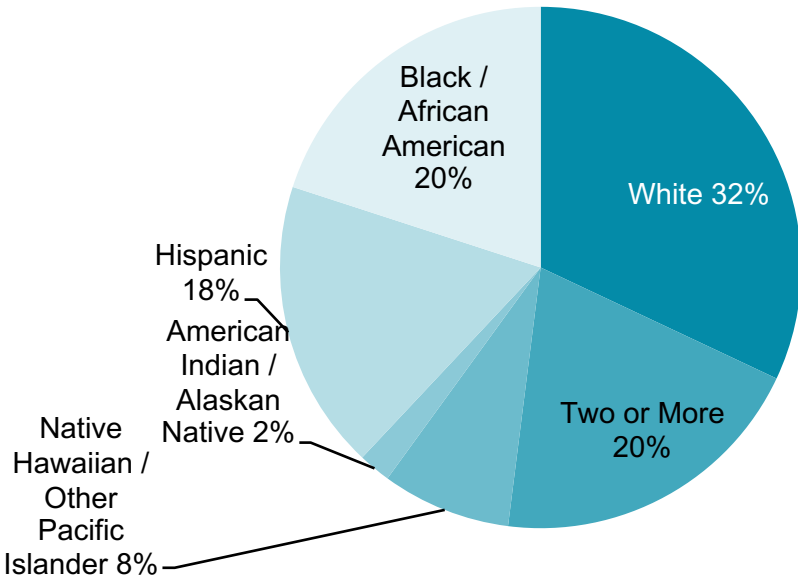
# Student Demographics 2018-2019

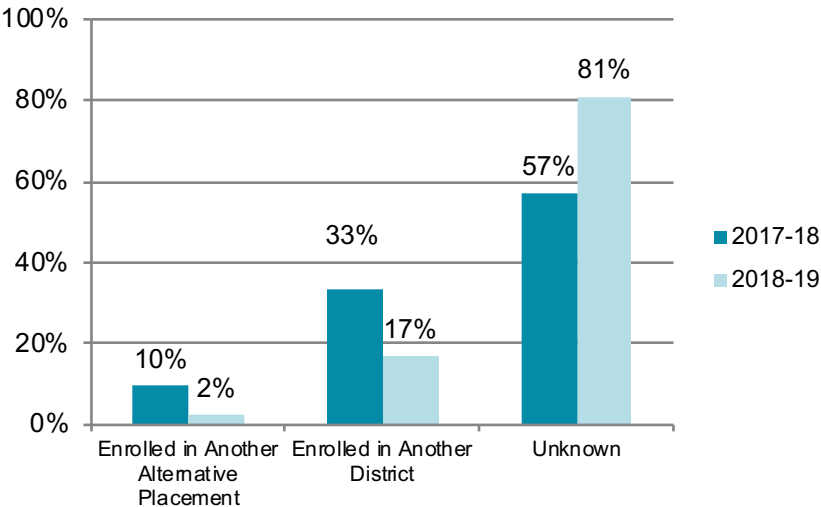

Participation rate criteria are in place to ensure district tests all eligible students.

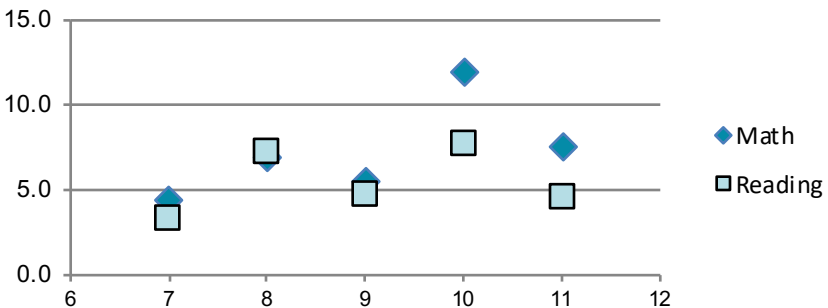
