

## **DISTRICT NEWSLETTER IMMUNIZATION INFORMATION**

### September

When you are registering your child to attend school, please bring immunization information with you. If your child is attending school and has received immunizations since last school year, please bring updated information as soon as possible.

### October

Please continue to bring in updated immunization information. This information must be provided to the school for input into the district's immunization database so that your child's record will reflect that they are up to date. Letters will be mailed this month to parents whose children have incomplete immunization information. Should you receive a letter, please provide requested information as soon as possible. The school nurse is available to address any questions that you may have. If you need assistance in locating a health care provider or clinic site, please contact your school nurse.

### November

Please continue to send or bring in immunization records to your child's school. Though many schools and districts may still be providing distance learning, Oregon school law still mandates for immunization compliance by February 17, 2021. Getting your child's immunizations completed as soon as possible will help to ready them for in school instruction when we return to school buildings. If you need assistance in locating a health care provider or clinic site, please contact your school nurse.

### December

If your child is still incomplete in their immunizations, please make arrangements to obtain vaccinations and to provide this information to the school. Exclusion day for state required vaccinations is Wednesday, February 17, 2021. Students who are not current will not be able to attend school until current immunization records are provided to school staff. If you need assistance in locating a health care provider or clinic site, please contact your school nurse.

### January

Exclusion day for state required vaccinations is Wednesday, February 17, 2021. Letters will be mailed to parents whose children are not up to date or whose records are incomplete. Should you receive a letter, please provide updated information to the school as soon as possible. Children who are not current for vaccinations by February 17<sup>th</sup> will not be able to attend school

until records are complete. If you need assistance in locating a health care provider or clinic site, please contact your school nurse.

### February

Exclusion day for state required immunizations is Wednesday, February 17<sup>th</sup>. Students who are not current will not be able to attend school until their records are complete. Please arrange for your child to receive needed immunizations so that they can remain in school. If you need assistance in locating a health care provider or clinic site, please contact your school nurse.

### March

Children who will be attending kindergarten in the 2021-2022 school year will need to be up to date with their immunizations to enroll. Please provide a record to your child's school when attending any enrollment activities.

### April

Oregon law now requires that school districts and schools post information regarding nonmedical exemption and exclusion rates on their web page. This information is updated annually based on information provided prior to exclusion day in February.

### May

Please continue to provide updated immunization records if your child receives vaccinations. These records are continually updated to ensure current status. If your child will be seeing a health care provider for summer camp or a sport physical, review their immunization status and bring updated records to your child's school.

### June

Please review your child's immunization records and visit your child's health care provider for needed vaccines. Remember to bring updated records to your child's school when they return in September 2021.
