## Program Description

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The Functional Living Skills is a full service program that serves K-12 and Transition-age students, providing individualized instruction for students to develop communication skills, socially appropriate behaviors, and personal management skills that are commensurate with their cognitive level of functioning. Services are individualized for each student and may also include motor, physical, assistive technology, and some vocational training. Students receive services, including medical care, to meet their individual physical and health needs while in school.

The Functional Living Skills program serves students from Multnomah County component school districts, and other school districts by contract.

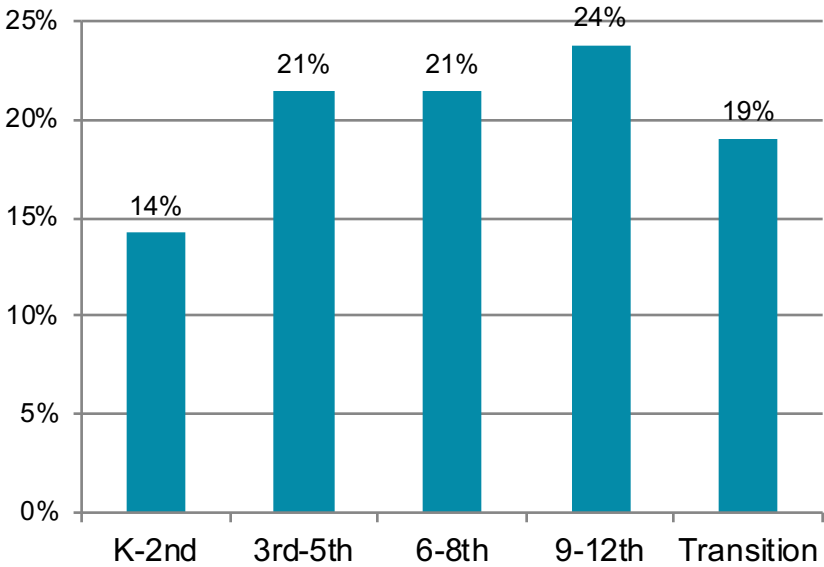
Students Transferred to Less Restrictive Environment in Home District

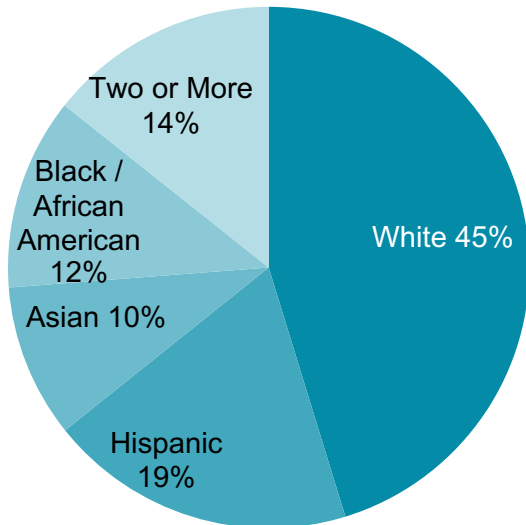
# Student Demographics 2018-2019

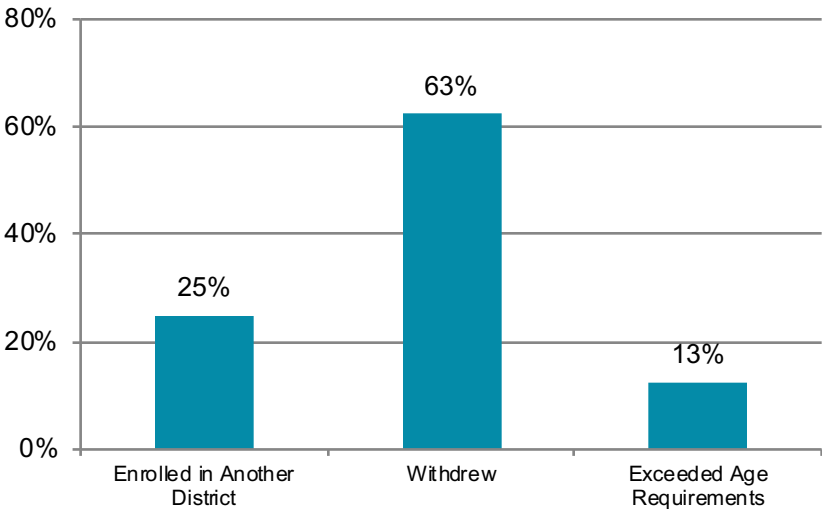

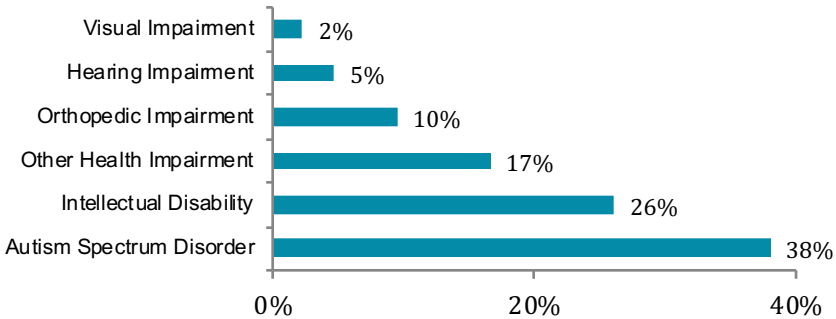

## Performance Measures

Students who are supported by the MESD Functional Living Skills program are assessed using the Unique Learning System (ULS). ULS is a standards-based curriculum that allows students to access material relevant to what is being taught in a general education curriculum related to science, history, math, and current events. Each lesson is differentiated and delivered according to student need; growth is progress monitored within the curriculum, and instruction is responsive and data-driven.
