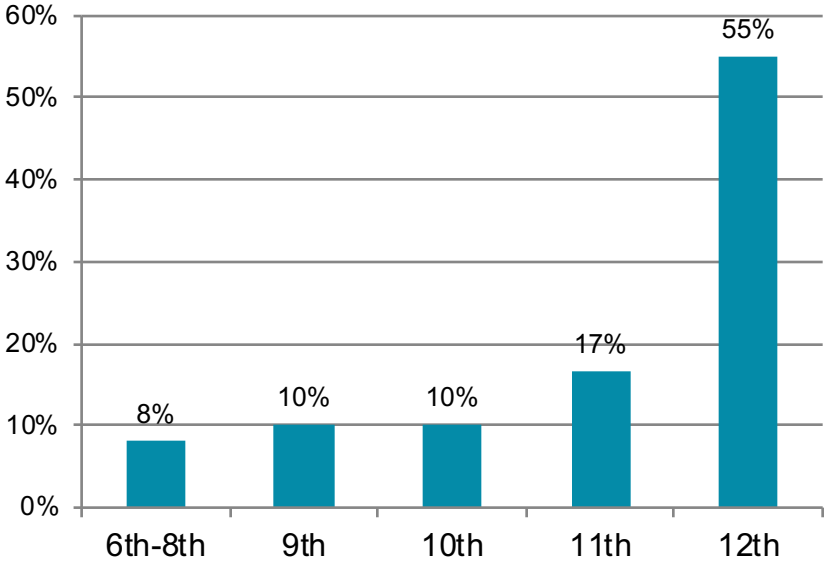

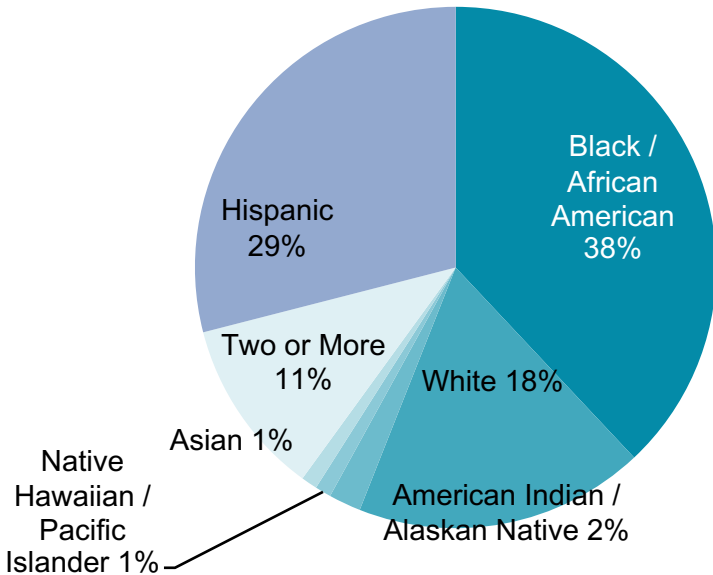

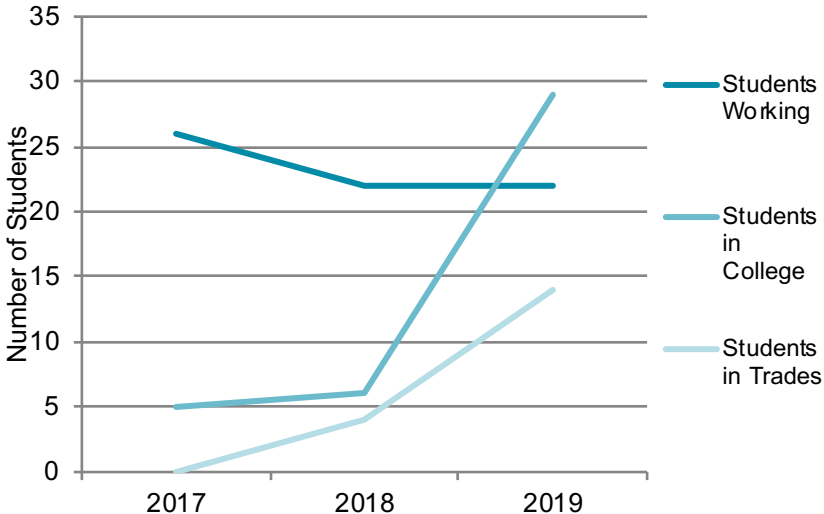

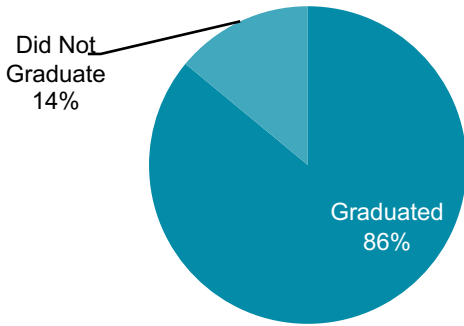

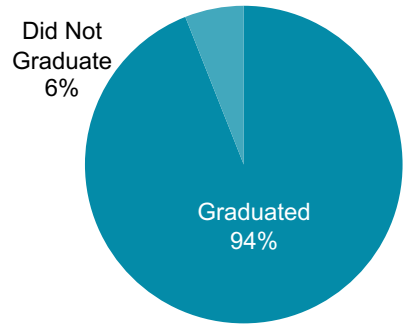
# Post Program Outcome



Percent On-Track Seniors That Graduated in One Year



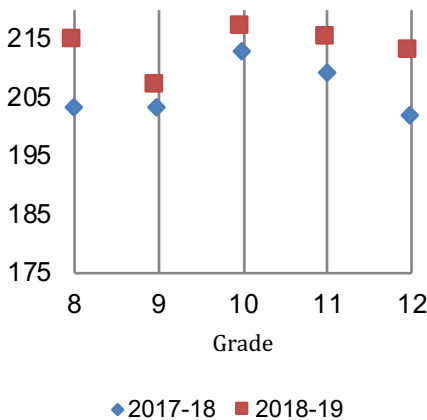
Percent On-Track Seniors That Graduated in Two Years



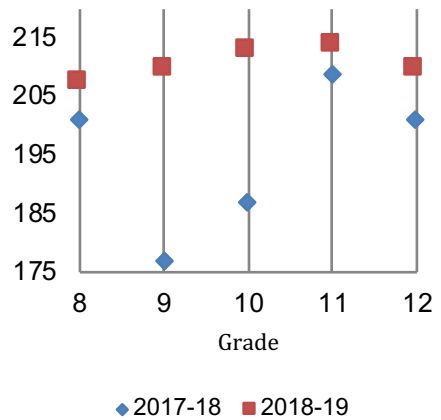
