









Hospital School Programs- General

Program Description

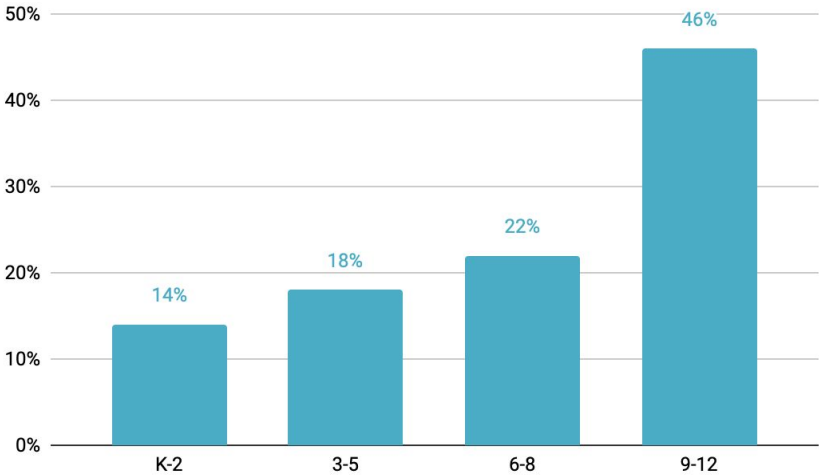
The Hospital School Program provides a flexible and motivational educational experience through instruction and educational support to students up to age 21 with significant, acute medical, rehabilitation or mental health needs during the course of their hospitalization and / or ongoing treatment. The General program includes sites at Doernbecher Children’s Hospital, Randall – Acute Care, Rehabilitation, and Kidney Care, and Shriners Children’s Hospital.

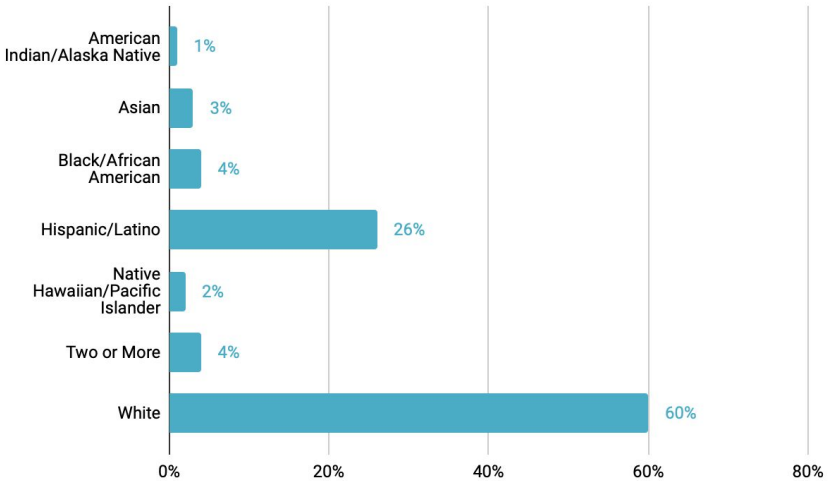

Race/Ethnicity of Students Served



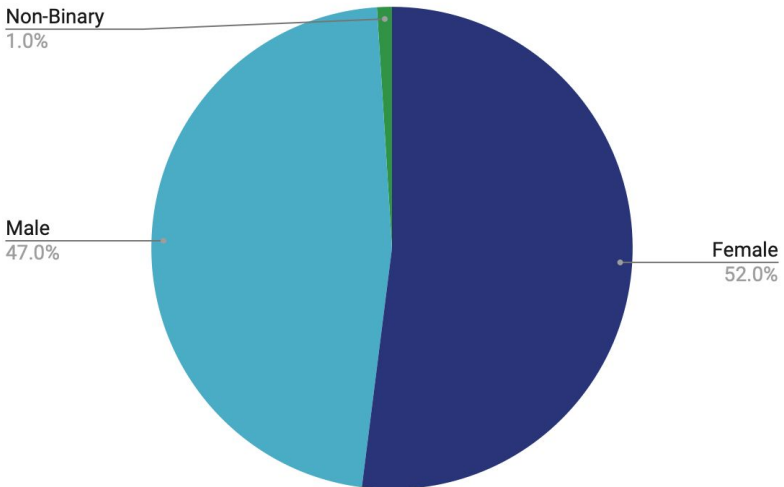

Gender Identity



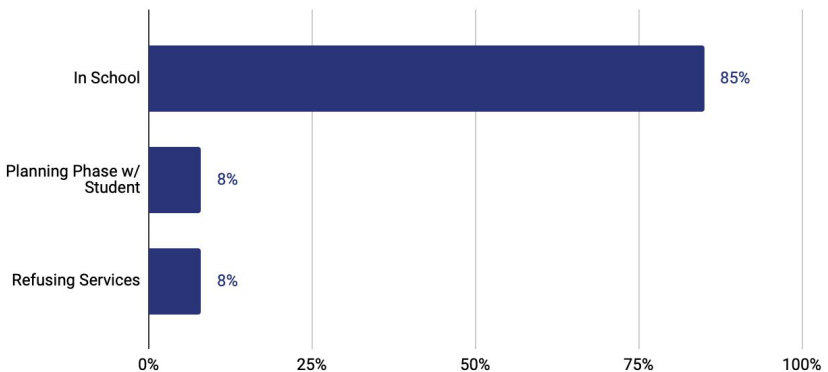
Performance Measures
