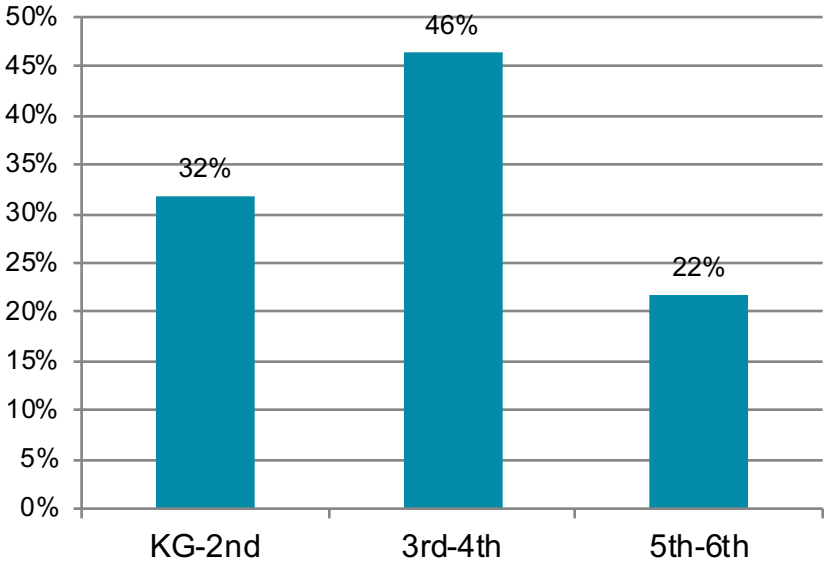
Students Served in a Calendar Year 110



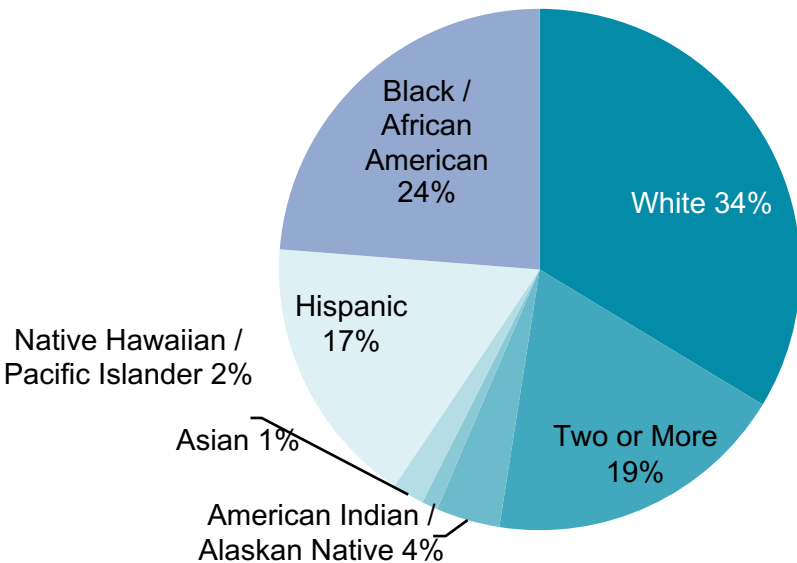
Students Transferred to Less Restrictive Environment 9

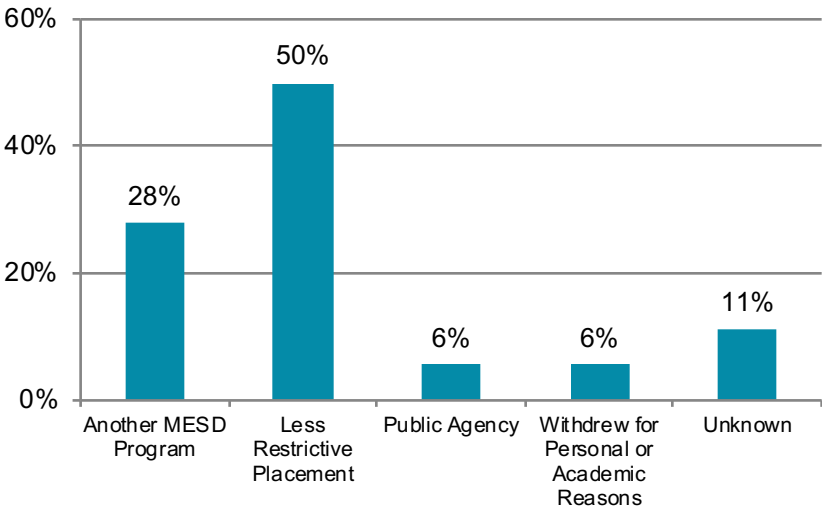

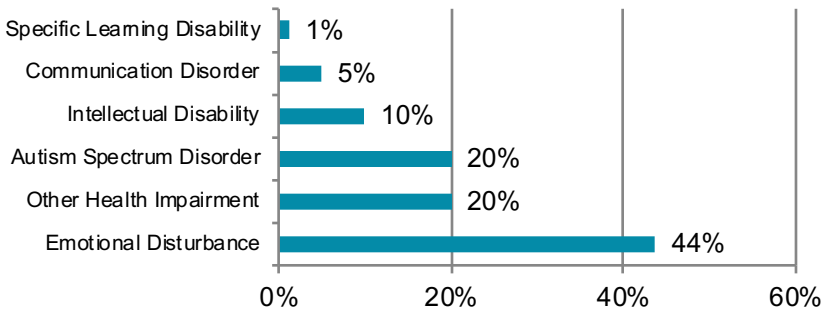
