# Working with a family needing immunizations? Student Health Center Contact + Special Immie Clinic Days

Are you working with a family that needs immunizations? If they have a family doctor, it will be easiest for them to see their doctor to get up-to-date on shots. Their clinic will have their records on file.

If they don't have access to a medical provider or are unable to get an appointment, refer them to the closest Multnomah County Student Health Center. Student Health Centers serve all K-12 aged Multnomah County youth. We accept all insurance types and serve the uninsured. There is no out-of-pocket cost for services at a Student Health Center (no cost or co-pay).

## When referring families, let them know to:

1. Call their closest Student Health Center to make an appointment (see map below):
  - There are options available Monday-Friday
  - **David Douglas has increased appointments available every Tuesday leading up to exclusion (Feb. 5, 12, 17)**
  - **Centennial is hosting all day immunizations clinics on Monday, Feb. 11, and Tuesday, Feb. 19 from 8 am-3:45 pm (last appointment is at 3:20 pm)**
2. Bring the Certificate of Immunization Status they received in the mail stating what shots their child needs and any other immunization documents they have.
3. Once seen, the family turns in completed paperwork to their school.
