






Program Description

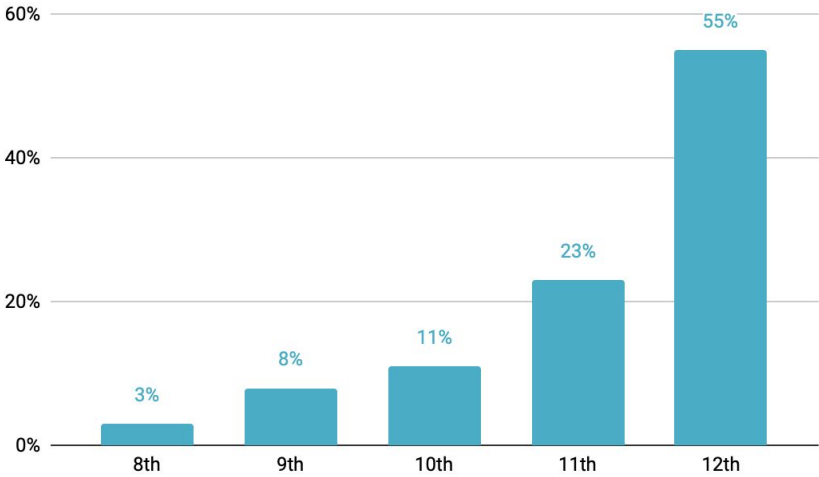

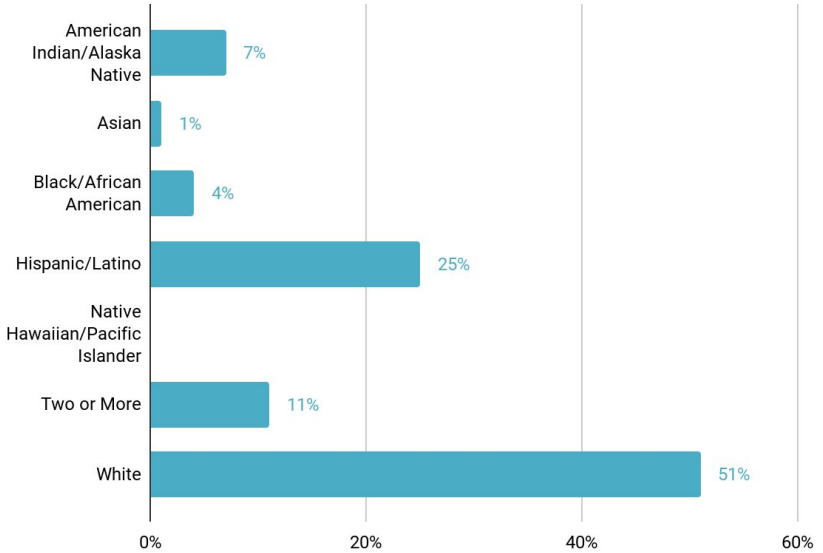

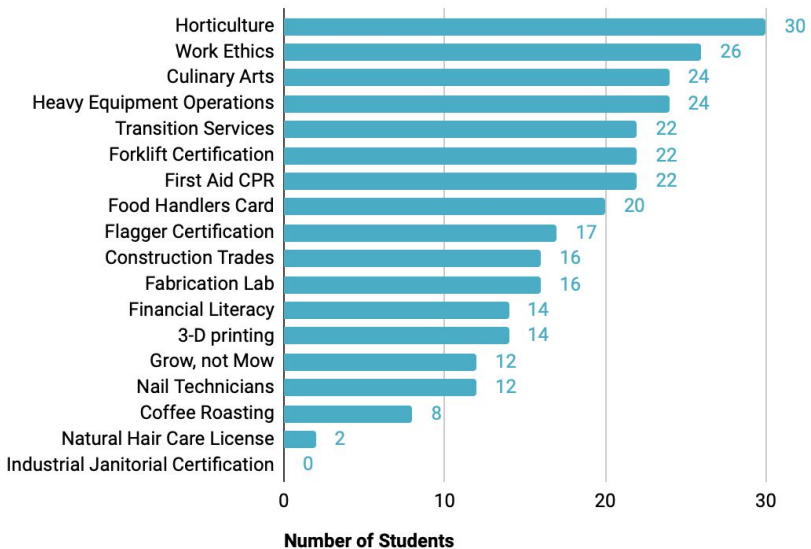
