

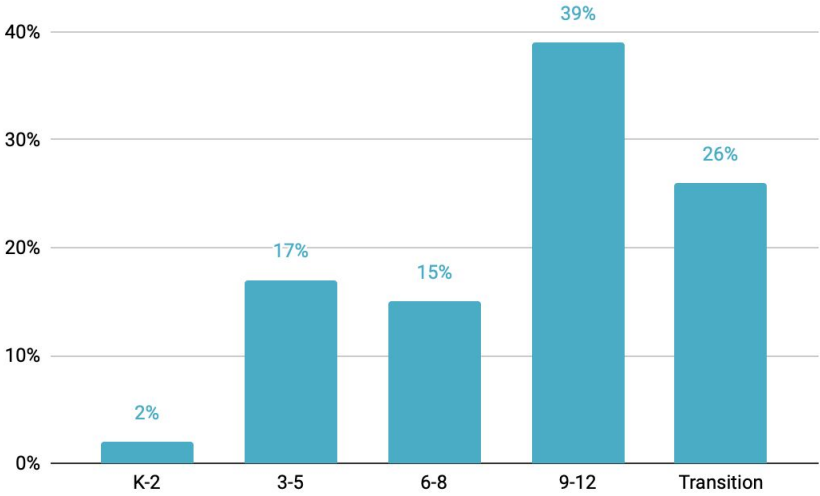
Wheatley serves students from Multnomah County and other school districts by contract.

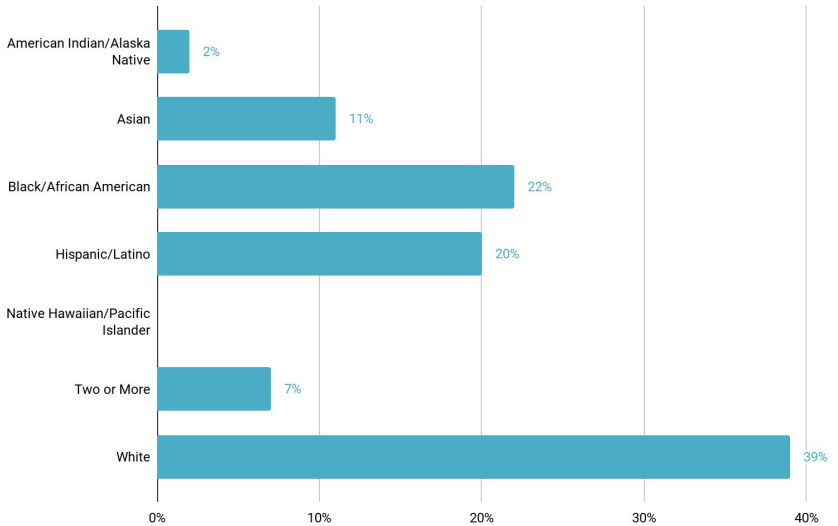

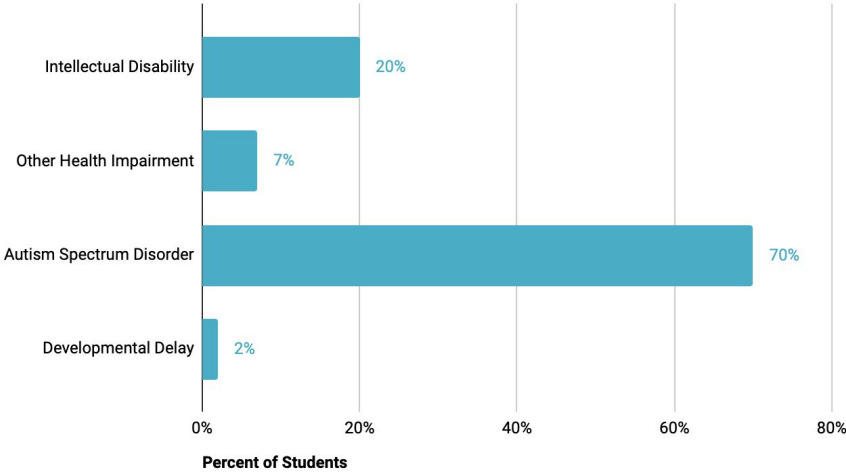
Grade Levels Served



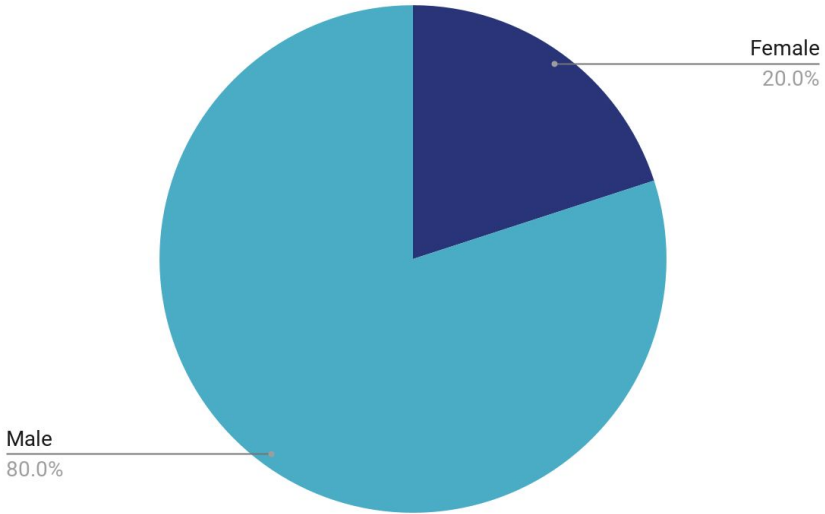
Race/Ethnicity of Students Served

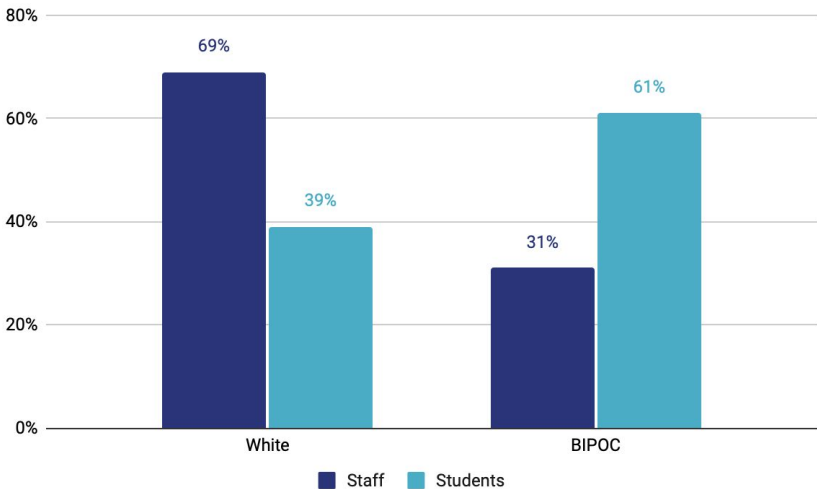

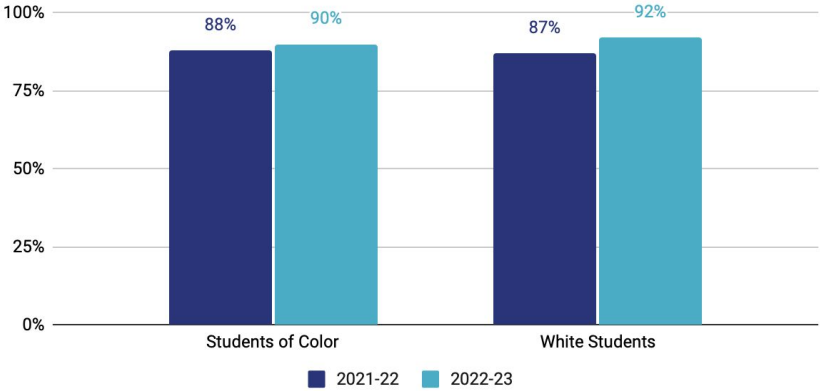
