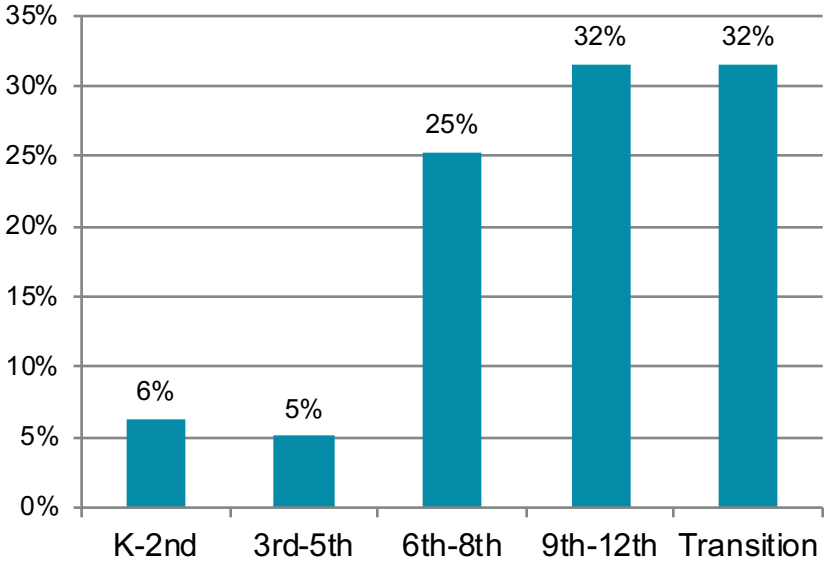

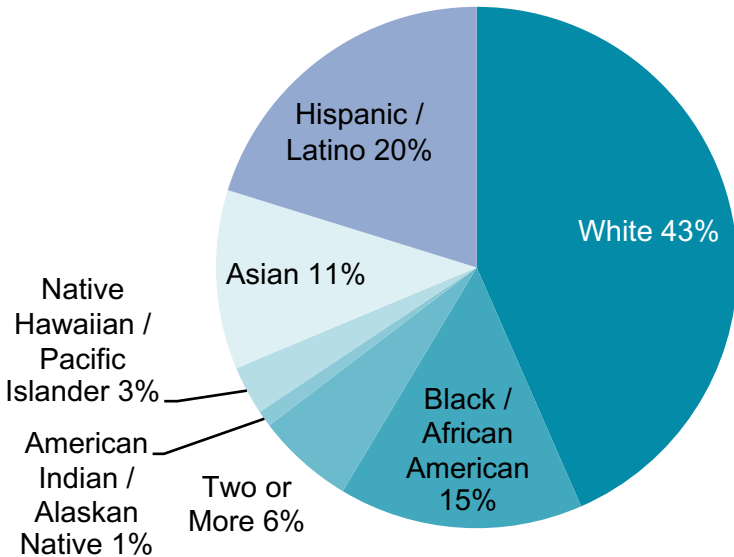

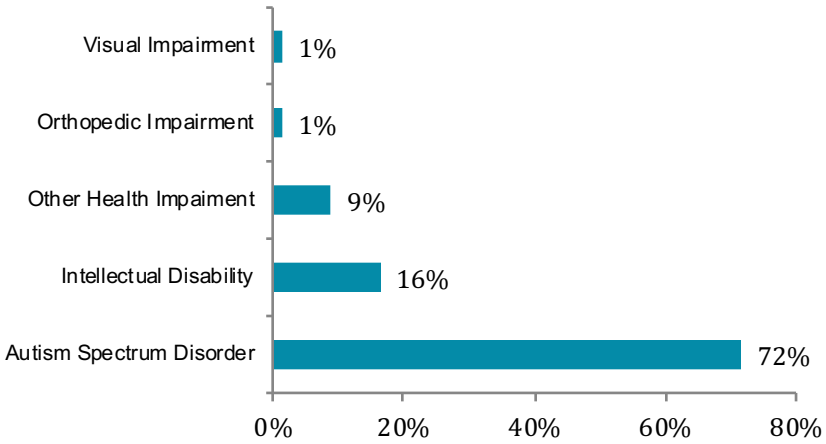

## Performance Measures

Students who are supported by the MESD FLS program are assessed using the Unique Learning System (ULS). ULS is a standards-based curriculum that allows students to access material relevant to what is being taught in a general education curriculum. Participation rate criteria are in place to ensure district tests all eligible students.
