
## **Program Description**

Educational services leading up to a diploma and/or GED are provided to students (ages 11-18) detained and/or incarcerated in the Yamhill Juvenile Detention Center in accordance with Oregon Administrative Rule 581-015-2585. The Yamhill JDEP School is located inside the Yamhill Court Complex which currently houses a maximum of eighteen youth at one time.


